Technical Services Superintendent

Reporting to the open pit Mining Manager the responsibilities of the Technical Services Superintendent will include:

Mine Engineer

Reporting to the Senior Mining Engineer this position entails:

- Ensuring design drawings are completed on time and according to specifications
- Reviewing built drawings for compliance and improvement opportunities.
